Adding Color with Stencils

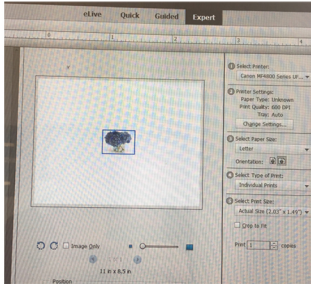

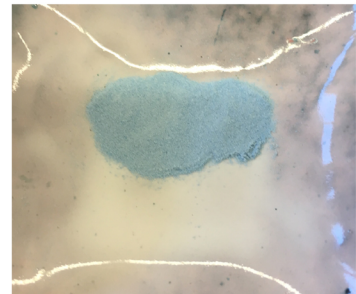
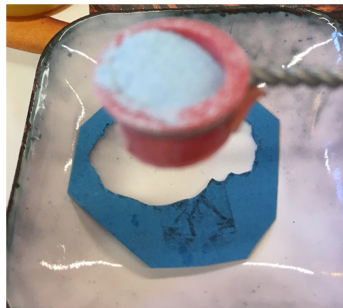
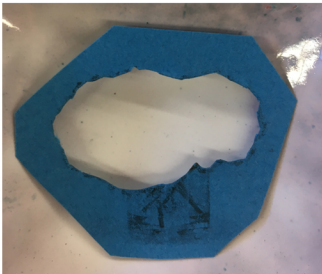


Finished Enamel Project

1. Prepare your metal by firing on a basecoat of white enamel



2. Size image and print onto decal paper and a piece of card stock



- 3. Cut out stencil and hold it down while sifting color on.**
- 4. Carefully lift off stencil and brush off any unwanted powder.**
- 5. Fire as usual until colored area is shiny and set.**
- 6. Apply decal as directed lining up over the colored area.**
- 7. Remove water and bubbles and let dry for at least 2 hours**
- 8. Fire again to 1490F for 1=1.5 minutes until shiny.**
