## Colorizing Fired-On Images with Chalks and/ or Glazes

## **Materials Needed**

- 1. Fired-On Images Decal Paper
- 2. Any Canon Black-Only Laser Printer (or HP but check the FAQ page on website first)
- 3. Clay Carbon (carbonless tracing paper)
- 4. Bisque tile
- 5. White glaze
- 6. Assorted colored glazes and/ or underglaze chalks
- 7. optional: laser compatible overhead transparency sheet
- 1. Glaze bisque tile with 2-3 coats white glaze and let dry thoroughly.



- 2. Size image to fit on tile
- 3. Print image onto clay carbon,

  Decal Paper\* and optional transparency sheet
- 4. Tape clay carbon over white glaze and draw around areas where you want color.
  \*If using cone 5/6 glaze wait to print decal onto decal paper until after glaze fire to account for shrinkage. Resize decal image and then print.









7. Fire to temp recommended for your white glaze.



- 8. Soak and slide decal over the colors and push out water and bubbles.
- 9. Fire to recommended decal firing temp depending on the \*glaze used.
- \*Check the chart in the instructions that came with your decal paper.
